

ADVICE ON LEAVING A LEGACY TO THE GREEK CAT WELFARE SOCIETY

If you wish to leave the Greek Cat Welfare Society a legacy we suggest that you take this form to your Solicitor when making your will. Your Solicitor will then be able to discuss exactly how much and in what form you would like to leave your legacy.

Leaving a legacy to the Greek Cat Welfare Society will help the Society to carry on with their valuable work with the stray and feral cats in Greece.

Listed below are answers to some of the questions which are most frequently asked

What type of legacy would benefit the GCWS most?

* A residuary legacy would benefit the Greek Cat Welfare Society the most because it is not lessened by the rate of inflation. A residuary legacy is the remainder of your estate after other specific bequests have been made.

Can I leave a specific sum of money to the Charity?

* A specific sum can be left to the Greek Cat Welfare Society. It is the simplest form of legacy. It is worth remembering that this can be linked directly to the cost of living, which means that it does not reduce over time.

Am I able to leave specific items to the Greek Cat Welfare Society?

* Gifts such as property, jewellery and antiques would be most welcome. Normally these would be sold to raise funds for the charity's work.

We suggest that if you do decide to leave the Greek Cat Welfare Society a legacy in your will, your solicitor could use one of the following phrases

If you wish to leave our Charity a sum of money:

I give to the Greek Cat Welfare Society (UK), Registered Charity No. 1008057, Registered office: 2,Victoria Grove, Bridport, Dorset, DT6 3AA the sum of £..... and I direct that a receipt signed by the Treasurer for the time being of the Society shall be a sufficient discharge for my executor

If you wish to leave the GCWS a residuary legacy or a percentage of the residue of your estate

I give all the residue or% (a percentage) of the residue of my estate to the Greek Cat Welfare Society (UK), Registered Charity No. 1008057, Registered office: 2,Victoria Grove, Bridport, Dorset, DT6 3AA and I direct that a receipt signed by the Treasurer for the time being of the Society shall be a sufficient discharge for my executor

You may wish the Greek Cat Welfare Society to act as your Executor in which case one of the following clauses will have to be written into your will

* "I give a legacy of £.....to the Greek Cat Welfare Society (UK), whose Registered office is: 2,Victoria Grove, Bridport, Dorset, DT6 3AA (Registered Charity No. 1008057) and I direct that a receipt signed by the Treasurer for the time being of the Society shall be a sufficient discharge for my executor."

* "I appoint as the executors of this my Will the Secretary and Treasurer for the time being of the Greek Cat Welfare Society (UK), whose Registered office is 2,Victoria Grove, Bridport, Dorset, DT6 3AA (Registered Charity No. 1008057)".
